



Field Crops II

The Field Crops II course examines Major Crops, which have been established as "industrial and energy plants" (cotton, flax, hemp, tobacco, sugar beet, sunflower, rapeseed, sesame, spindle and castor oil). Botanical characteristics are described and growth stages are analyzed in combination with the factors that affect them. In addition, information is given related to the classification, the cultivated varieties and hybrids, the cultivation technique (rotation, soil preparation, fertilization, sowing, irrigation, harvesting), the enemies and the diseases that damage them, as well as the quality characteristics of the individual products
