

Pomology

The aim of the Pomology course is the understanding and the ability to use the principles of fruit growing by the undergraduate students of the Department. The course includes the following topics: a) the familiarization with the main fruit trees; b) the understanding of the principles, methods and modern technologies of fruit growing; c) the propagation, including crafting, of the fruit tree rootstocks and varieties; d) the use of modern canopy management methods; e) the design and establishment of modern fruit orchards with appropriate rootstocks and varieties and adapted to the local environmental conditions; e) establishing of fruit tree nurseries.
