This symposium will delve into current and emerging issues, encompassing topics such as the impact of olive oil and olives on public/planetary health (Mediterranean diet and health outcomes, nutrition and foods recommendations, and sustainable futures); quality, authenticity, and chemistry of olive oil; marketing strategies; the upcycling of olive oil side-streams in animal welfare; the bioeconomy (circularity and sustainability); and the challenges and opportunities posed by climate change. The program is designed to feature presentations, roundtable discussions, tastings, and social gatherings, with a specific focus on stimulating active participation and fostering collaboration among attendees.
